





The Osage Beach Police Department will be participating in the National Click It or Ticket Campaign, May 20 thru June 2.

Officers will be focusing on traffic violations and those motorist not wearing seat belts.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration there were 10,076 un-bucked passenger vehicle occupants killed in traffic crashes in 2017. In that same year, 55% of passenger vehicle occupants killed at night (6 pm to 5:59 am) were not wearing their seat belts.

If we can keep one person from being killed in a traffic crash because they were not wearing their seatbelt because our agency participated in the Click It or Ticket Campaign, we helped make a difference.

Remember that Osage Beach has a Primary Seat Belt Ordinance which means that Osage Beach Officers may stop you for not wearing your seat belt without any other violations.








Happenings Around Town
