# **Department Comments and Recommendation:**

The bid opening for this project was on 10/22/22. The City received 4 bids for these projects. The bid tab is attached. The low bidder is Don Schneider Excavating. The City has worked with this vendor recently on the Greenwood Circle Drainage Improvements project, but they have not done any road improvement work with us previously, so I did check their references and found no problems.

This is a situation where we combined two projects with similar work together to try and get better material pricing.

The Amy Lane project is a project where we are partnering with the Osage Beach Special Road District (OBSRD). Engineering and construction inspection services are the responsibility of the City and the cost of construction is the responsibility of OBSRD. Prior to this project being advertised, we did provide an updated cost estimate to OBSRD of \$128,394. This updated cost was approved by their board. The low bid for this work is \$134,247.00 so I will be seeking approval from the OBSRD for the difference prior to the second reading of this project.

The Case Road Driveway Improvements Project is a project needed to correct safety and drainage issues associated with the driveway shared by 1284 and 1327 Case Rd. The safety and drainage issue was created by the City when we improved Case road several years ago.

Due to other work that the contractor has already scheduled, the project will not be started until the spring of 2023. This project will be carried over and included in the 2023 budget.

I recommend approval.

## **City Attorney Comments:**

Per City Code 110.230, Bill 22-84 is in correct form.

#### **City Administrator Comments:**

Within the line item *Misc. Streets/Roads (20-00-773155)*, Case Road Driveway Reconstruction was budgeted in FY2022 at \$50,000. This project was initially a carryover from FY2021.

Within the line item *Special Road District Projects* (20-00-773210), Amy Lane Reconstruction was budgeted in FY2022 at \$78,000 and 100% funded by the OBSRD.

The FY2023 Operating Budget Draft #1, currently in review, shows both projects included as budgeted to be completed in FY2022. Due to new information as to the timing of the projects, both will be carried over into the FY2023 Operating Budget in the

Draft #2 budget as approved in this Bill.

Regarding Amy Lane Reconstruction, if the OBSRD approves increasing their funding to match construction costs at 100%, there will be no net change to the ending available cash balances for year-end FY2023.

<u>WHEREAS</u> , the Owner, in the manner prescribed by law, has publicly opened, examined and canvassed the bids submitted in response to the published advertisement therefor, and as a result of such canvass has determined and declared the aforesaid Contractor to be the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder for the said work and has duly awarded to the said Contractor a contract therefor, for the sum or sums named in the Contractor's bid, a copy thereof being attached to and made a part of this contract.
NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the compensation to be paid to the Contractor and of the mutual agreements herein contained, the Parties to these presents have agreed and hereby agree, the Owner for itself and its successors, and the Contractor for its, his, or their executors and administrators, as follows:

#### **Department Comments and Recommendation:**

This Ordinance will amend the previous contract approved November 21, 2019 (Bill 19.55) and raise the fuel purchase limit not to exceed \$1,150,000 per year. Due to the high price of fuel this year and because we are still seeing an increase in fuel sales, this contract and a budget amendment are needed for future fuel purchases.

#### **City Attorney Comments:**

Per City Code 110.230, Bill 22-85 is in correct form.

#### **City Administrator Comments:**

A first and second reading is requested to timely increase the not-to-exceed authority for the remainder of this year and future years under the contracted terms. At the previous Board of Aldermen meeting a motion was presented and approved, but in error, as a motion does not amend a contract put in place via a bill. This bill appropriately amends the initial bill 19.55, modifying the terms of the contract which include an increase to the not-to-exceed amount.

The purchase of Aviation fuel and Jet-A fuel is coded to the applicable expenditure accounts, 45- and 47-00-762500 Aviation Fuel Resell and 47- and 47-00-762550 Jet-A Fuel Resell. The sale of said fuel is coded to the applicable revenue accounts. Based on the projected FY2022 year-end calculation, a budget amendment follows this request.

- 3. Naegler shall invoice City showing the date of delivery, amounts of fuel delivered, types of fuel delivered, cost per gallon and total cost of fuel, state fuel tax added (where applicable), and federal fuel tax added. Naegler shall show delivery costs which are added to deliveries.
- 4. City shall remit payment to Naegler monthly upon receipt of a fuel invoice where practical.
- 5. Naegler shall process credit cards through Phillips on the City's behalf for purchases made by City's customers at the City's airport.
- 6. Naegler shall provide City a statement of credit cards processed on a monthly basis, no later than the 10th of the month for the prior month.

Such statement shall indicate the gross amounts of credit cards processed, the fees charged by Phillips for the processing of such cards and the net amount of cards to be paid from Naegler to City. Naegler shall also include, with such statement, full payment to the city in the amount of the net credit cards for the prior month. Upon request, Naegler shall provide a daily breakdown of credit cards processed on behalf of the city.

#### **Department Comments and Recommendation:**

Cochran Engineering has been working through easement issues with the Golfview Lane to Sea Breeze Drive Water Loop Project that is currently budgeted for 2022. If this is approved, this property swap will go a long way toward making this project a reality. This project will be carried over to the 2023 budget.

Three easements are needed from Antler Ridge Trading Co before we can move forward. This company has stated that they are willing to provide us with all three of the easements that we need if we provide them with the old Muff Water Tower property. Two of the easements that we need are associated with the Muff Water Tower parcel and the other easement is related to the path that the new water line will take through another section of their property.

Using valuation data from previous easements and property sales that the City has been involved with, we came up with the valuation listed below. The reality of this

situation is that the Muff Tower property is completely land locked by property already owned by Anter Ridge Trading Company and has no real value to the City. If I tried to sell this small piece of property, the only interested party would be Antler Ridge and I would get nowhere near the value listed below. (See attached Map of the Muff Tower Property)

That said, we do have an interest in looping the water line that will have to run through their property and the project will not happen unless we get these easements.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OSAGE BEACH, MISSOURI AMENDING CHAPTER 150 IN THE MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING NEW 45 DAY NOTICE DEADLINES WITHIN THE PROCESS FOR THE CITY'S CONSIDERATION OF REDEVELOPMENT PLANS AND TAX ABATEMENTS PURSUANT TO THE URBAN REDEVELOPMENT CORPORATIONS LAW, CHAPTER 353 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the Urban Redevelopment Corporations Law, Chapter 353 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri ("Chapter 353"), allows the City to establish policies and procedures in association with the consideration of development plans and grants of tax abatement; and

WHEREAS, the City in chapter 150 of the municipal code has established policies and procedures for the consideration of development plans and grants of tax abatement pursuant to Chapter 353, including requiring certain information to be included in a development plan and establishing formal notice procedures for public hearings required by Chapter 353; and

WHEREAS, the board desires to require an expansion of the notice period from 15 days to 45 days for consideration of development plans under chapter 150 of the municipal code:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF OSAGE BEACH, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That Section 150.040 of Chapter 150 be and is hereby repealed.
- Section 2. A new Section numbered 150.040 of the Osage Beach Code of Ordinances be and is hereby enacted as follows:

Section 150.040 <u>Public Hearing Notices</u>. Notices of any public hearing scheduled by the Board of Aldermen pursuant to Section 150.030 shall be given in the following manner:

- (a) <u>Independently Owned Property</u> If the development plan relates to property not currently owned by the applicant, notice of the public hearing shall be given by hand delivery, certified mail or nationally-recognized overnight courier service to the owner or owners of property within the redevelopment area described in the development plan at least forty-five (45) days prior to the public hearing;
- (b) <u>Publication.</u> Notice of the public hearing shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation serving the City at least fifteen (15) days prior to the public hearing; and
- (c) <u>Notice to Affected Taxing Districts</u> Notice of the public hearing, together with a written statement of the impact on ad valorem real property taxes that the tax abatement described in the development plan will have on political subdivisions affected by the tax abatement, shall be given by hand delivery, certified mail or nationally-recognized overnight courier service, to the political subdivisions affected by the tax

abatement at least forty-five (45) days prior to the public hearing.

(d) <u>First Reading</u> The Public Hearing for any development plan considered by the Board of Aldermen under this section shall be held before the first reading of the ordinance considering a development plan.

### Section 3. Severability

The chapters, sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by the valid judgment or degree of any Court of any competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this ordinance since the same would have been enacted by the Board of Aldermen without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional or invalid phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

### Section 4. Repeal of Ordinances not to affect liabilities, etc.

Whenever any part of this ordinance shall be repealed or modified, either expressly or by implication, by a subsequent ordinance, that part of the ordinance thus repealed or modified shall continue in force until the subsequent ordinance repealing or modifying the ordinance shall go into effect unless therein otherwise expressly provided; but no suit, prosecution, proceeding, right, fine or penalty instituted, created, given, secured or accrued under this ordinance previous to its repeal shall not be affected, released or discharged but may be prosecuted, enjoined and recovered as fully as if this ordinance or provisions had continued in force, unless it shall be therein otherwise expressly provided.

At the 08/04/22 Board of Alderman meeting we had a discussion related to prioritizing the assessment of privately owned roads within Osage Beach. At that time, Alderman O'Steen asked me to research whether or not the private roads included in the 2018 private road assessment had maintenance agreements on file with the county. That research has been done and what we found is attached. What we found does not provide much new information.

What I am trying to do here is come up with a process that will guide the City through how we prioritize these roads and decide which roads to work with the Osage Beach Special Road District (OBSRD) to bring up to City Design Guidelines (or as close as we can to City Design Guidelines) to eventually bring them into City inventory. This process should also include what resources property owners living on these roads have to assist with bringing their roads up to City Standards.

With the Board's permission, I would like to work with the OBSRD to reevaluate this list.

Several roads on the list have already been improved or are in the process of being approved and some roads not on the list have been brought forward for consideration.

Using the methodology listed on the second page of the 2018 private road assessment, I would like to work with the OBSRD to update this list, reassess these roads to see if anything has changed since the list was originally created and possibly add other private roads that may have infrastructure issues now, but didn't back in 2018.





We have searched the land records in Camden County, Missouri and in Miller County, Missouri and do hereby certify that we find the following in regard to the described land,

### **Clearwood Lane:**

Shown on the plat of "Bella Harbor Subdivision" in Plat Book 128, Page 40 and on the plat of "Bella Harbor Subdivision, First Addition" in Plat Bok 135, Page 3. Dedicated to the use of all owners of lots in Bella Harbor Subdivision and is a private street.

**NOTE:** There is a portion of Clearwood Lane that remains unplatted. It is referenced as a "an existing driveway" in the legal description for Parcel No. 08-1.0-01.3-000.0-008-050.000 in Book 789, Page 96 and has been referred to that way since said legal description was created in 2006. No easement was found regarding said driveway.

### Melba Circle:

Shown on the plat of "Shadow Woods" in Plat Book 20, Page 24. Dedicated to the private and common use of present and future lot owners in the subdivision for the purposes of ingress and egress and the installation and maintenance of utilities.

**NOTE:** There is a portion of Melba Circle that remains unplatted (as shown on GIS). No easement was found regarding the unplatted portion of Melba Circle. No mention of road ownership or maintenance appears in the CCRs found of record, although there is a HOA there (Osage Beach Harbor Property Owners Association).

### **Knight Court:**

Shown on the plat of "Tara Dude Ranch No. 2" in Plat Book 22, Page 45. Dedicated to the private and common use of lot owners in the subdivision (not a public roadway). Roads are not mentioned in the CCRs found of record. There is a "Well Agreement and Dedication" recorded in Book 268, Page 299 which addresses the road maintenance, etc. in Section II. In 2010 the subdivision was replated in Plat Book 120, Page 1. The original roadway was vacated, and a new roadway was platted. Said new roadway was dedicated to the lot owners of the new plat as a means of ingress and egress, parking, and for the installation and maintenance of public utilities. The portion of the roadway between Dude Ranch Road and the southeast line of the subdivision was not shown on the new plat, and no other easement was found of record regarding that section of Knight Court.

#### **Driftwood Lane:**

Unplatted roadway. Described as an easement (as well as Pintail Lane) on the deeds of the properties utilizing the road(s). The roadway was surveyed by David Krehbiel and Harms Engineering Company on survey marked V-249 as the original metes and bounds described property was split into 10 tracts (or lots) sometime between July 1963 and August 1973.

### **Sumach Lane:**

Unplatted roadway. Created in "Establishment of Easement for Roadway" in Book 119, Page 314. Said easement is for the private use of the Lots owners of Lots 36, 37, 38 and 39 (Osage Beach Third Addition) only. Although road maintenance is mentioned in the CCRs of Osage Beach Third Addition, it is not clear if Sumach Lane is included. No other maintenance agreement was found of record.

#### Aver Road:

Although Aver Road appears on several plats filed in both Camden and Miller Counties, it is not dedicated to the public on any of those plats. Aver Road is referred to as a 25 foot right-of-way adjacent to the tennis courts on Quit Claim Deeds filed in both Camden and Miller Counties (see attached).

There is a Road Maintenance Agreement (filed in Book 316, Page 324, Camden County) for the paved road as shown on the plat of Indian Pointe Place Subdivision, though the road referred to is in Miller County. The CCRs for the subdivision (filed in Book O, Page 603, Miller County) also addresses the dedication and maintenance of the road.

Although the addresses appear to be Osage Beach on both sides of the county line, the Miller County GIS shows Aver Road lies within the city limits of Lake Ozark in Miller County.
