PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION SHEET CAREFULLY TO AVOID DELAYS IN THE PERMITTING PROCESS

The City of Osage Beach enforces the ICC 2018 International Building Code, International Residential Code, International Fire Code, International Plumbing Code, International Mechanical Code, International Fuel Gas Code, International Property Maintenance Code, the 2017 National Electrical Code, and the City of Osage Beach Design Guidelines.

Application Process and Review Time

Incomplete applications will not be accepted or reviewed.

PLEASE SUBMIT ALL PERMIT APPLICATIONS AND SUPPORTING PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND DOCUMENTS VIA EMAIL. COMPLETE APPLICATION SUBMITTALS SHOULD BE SENT TO buildingdepartment@osagebeach.org

To obtain a **blasting permit**, the applicant must first submit the required Blasting Notification Form to the Missouri Division of Fire Safety. Once this is complete, the applicant should submit the following to the City of Osage Beach Building Official.

Required Documents

- ☐ Completed and Signed Blasting Permit Application
- ☐ Legible site map must be attached to the application showing the following information:
 - Location including topography
 - Location of property lines, gas lines, power lines, and other utilities
 - Location of any buildings in the blasting area
- ☐ A copy of the blaster's certification
- ☐ Signed [City Design Guidelines](#)

Additional Documents that may be required

If on-site storage of explosives will take place, the following information must be submitted:

- ☐ Type of storage magazine
 - o Above ground
 - o Below ground
- ☐ Exact location of storage magazine on a site map including longitude and latitude
- ☐ Access roads, permanent or temporary to storage site
- ☐ Location of nearest fire hydrant to the storage site
- ☐ Location of property lines, gas pipelines, power lines, other utilities within 500 feet of storage site
- ☐ Location of any buildings within 500 feet of storage site

Blasting permits are to be posted, visible from the road, at the job site.

This permit can be revoked or modified at any time.

Blasting Permits are valid for 10 days.

Fees

A Minimum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) in the form of a bond, a liability insurance policy, or as otherwise determined by the City will be required.

NOTICE:

Applicant shall notify the City of Osage Beach Public Safety Department no more than 1 hour prior to using permitted explosives

The City's Design Guidelines are a detailed supplement to the City's Municipal Code, Ordinances, and sets forth the requirements and policies for the design of City infrastructure. The primary goal of the design guidelines is to ensure public safety and provide a high quality environment for those living and visiting our great City.

City infrastructure shall be designed and constructed in accordance with the following:

- Missouri Department of Highways and Transportation Commission Project Design Manual
- Missouri Department of Highways Standard Specifications
- American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) Policy for the Geometric Design of Highways and Streets
- Missouri Department of Natural Resources Regulations
- International Building Code
- National Electric Code
- International Plumbing Code
- International Mechanical Code
- International Fire Code

And includes additional standards, policies and ordinances as stated therein.
