

2025 MANAGED DEER HUNT RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

- 1. All individuals shall comply with the Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) 2025 Archery Deer Hunting Regulations.
- 2. All individuals shall comply with all city ordinances as detailed in Section 207: "Deer Control and Hunting Regulations" of the City Code.
- 3. All individuals must provide a valid MDC hunter certification or equivalent to obtain a City MDH permit.
- 4. All individuals seeking to hunt within Osage Beach city limits shall register with Osage Beach Parks and Recreation (OBPR). A 2025 Osage Beach Managed Deer Hunt Permit will be issued at no cost at the time of registration.
- 5. All individuals shall keep the Managed Deer Hunt Permit, assigned to them, on their person, at all times, while hunting.
- 6. All individuals shall display the Managed Deer Hunt Parking Pass provided by OBPR in the front windshield of their vehicle while hunting.
- 7. All individuals shall report all deer harvest information to OBPR.
- 8. Designated City-owned property will be available for reservation on a first-come, first-serve basis to members of the public who have been issued a Managed Deer Hunt Permit.
- 9. Only one individual or party will be allowed to hunt on City-owned property at a time.
- 10. All individuals seeking to hunt on private property within Osage Beach city limits must get approval from the owner of that property. Landowners must register their property by completing and submitting a "2025 Managed Deer Hunt Landowner Application" to OBPR.
- 11. All individuals shall only be permitted to hunt on the date(s) and location(s) as approved by OBPW. This applies to City-owned and private properties.
- 12. It is expected that if an individual requests a piece of property for a specific time that they hunt the property during that time.
- 13. No individual/party will be able to reserve a piece of property for more than a week. However, it is strongly encouraged to reserve a piece of property daily to allow more people the opportunity to hunt

- 14. Every reasonable attempt to remove all remains of harvested deer promptly from the property shall be made and disposed of according to MDC recommendations
- 15. For individuals utilizing blinds/stands, they shall be removed on the last day you have reserved and cannot be set up prior to your reserve date. All blinds/stands shall be portable. The City is not responsible for blinds/stands.
- 16. Hunters are responsible for the removal of all trash and personal belongings that are brought onto the hunting property.
- 17. Violation of any of these rules may result in the forfeiture of your rights to participate in future Managed Deer Hunts.
- 14. The Osage Beach City Park on Hatchery Rd has time and date restrictions. ALL HUNTING WILL BE DONE BY 10:00 AM.
